Official Patriot Park Opening Set for Sept. 3

STOYSTOWN—As interest grows in the efforts of the Patriot Park Foundation, Foundation members are inviting the media to share information about a series of notable events over the next month. Engaged in a successful fundraising campaign, Patriot Park is located just west of the Flight 93 National Memorial entrance along U.S. Rt. 30.

The planned events are:

Aug. 17: The Foundation will begin planting over 7,000 American flags in the Field of Honor Flag Plaza to commemorate the U.S. servicemen and servicewomen who have, since 9-11-01, lost their lives defending our freedom in the Global War on Terrorism (GWOT). Sept. 2: The Remembering Our Fallen Tribute Towers will arrive at Patriot Park and remain at the park through the Labor Day weekend. Delivery of the towers will begin in Shanksville and proceed through the Flight 93 National Memorial to the Patriot Park site, where local school students will assist with the set-up of the Tribute Towers.

Sept. 2 through Sept. 6: The Global War on Terror History Project will also be on the property with an educational exhibit.

Sept. 3: Patriot Park Foundation will officially open Patriot Park with a Dedication Ceremony. The program will begin at 10:00 a.m. and feature patriotic music and a keynote speech by acclaimed author Sean Parnell, a decorated veteran of the GWOT.

The Mission of Patriot Park Foundation is to honor our Global War on Terror Armed Forces and their families for their sacrifice to preserve and protect our freedom; to share with Patriot Park visitors, through stories and displays, the actions our military personnel so courageously carry out; and, to raise awareness of their continued need for our support.
